Climate Justice

- 1. Radical climate action, based on justice and equality
- 2. Build segregated cycle lanes throughout the country
- 3. Free public transport for all, urban or rural
- 4. Stop all importation of fossil fuels, prioritising coal, prioritising coal from Colombia
- 5. Revoke all fossil fuel exploration and extraction licences

Freedom of Information

- 1. Reject Articles 15 ("Link Tax") and 17 ("Upload filters") of the new EU Copyright Directive
- 2. Effective internet policies, following advice from technology experts
 - Note: technology experts; people with objective, fact-based, expertise on the relevant technological measures. Not technology company executives – they're business people. Nor those who want reforms but disregard potential unintended consequences.
- 3. "Fake news": Prohibit the use by government departments and agencies of false information, or misrepresented facts to promote government policy
- 4. Reject the decision to seal abuse reports for 75 years
- 5. Protect RTÉ
 - Full publicly-funded no more dependent on ads
 - Restate editorial independence sanction ministers and TDs who threaten RTÉ in response to editorial decisions
- 6. Remove charges from Freedom of Information requests

Housing

Radical measures to address homelessness and housing demand

- 1. Authorise and fund the *building* and *management* of local authority housing.
- 2. Set housing policies that prioritise the public good over the interests of private profit
- 3. Promise to treat *all* homeless people with compassion and respect, *regardless* of the reason for the homelessness.
 - No more stealing and destroying the last pieces of personal property of homeless people because you want a pretty view.

Public Services

- 1. Accept that the Public Services Card is a mess. Ditch it. If such a thing is *really* necessary, replace it only with something that is legal and has real, genuine public support.
- 2. Implement Sláintecare.
 - Just stop the political messing-about, and get on with it.
- 3. Real reform for the Seanad
 - Open franchise to Dáil voters
 - Demographic constituencies, not geographic
